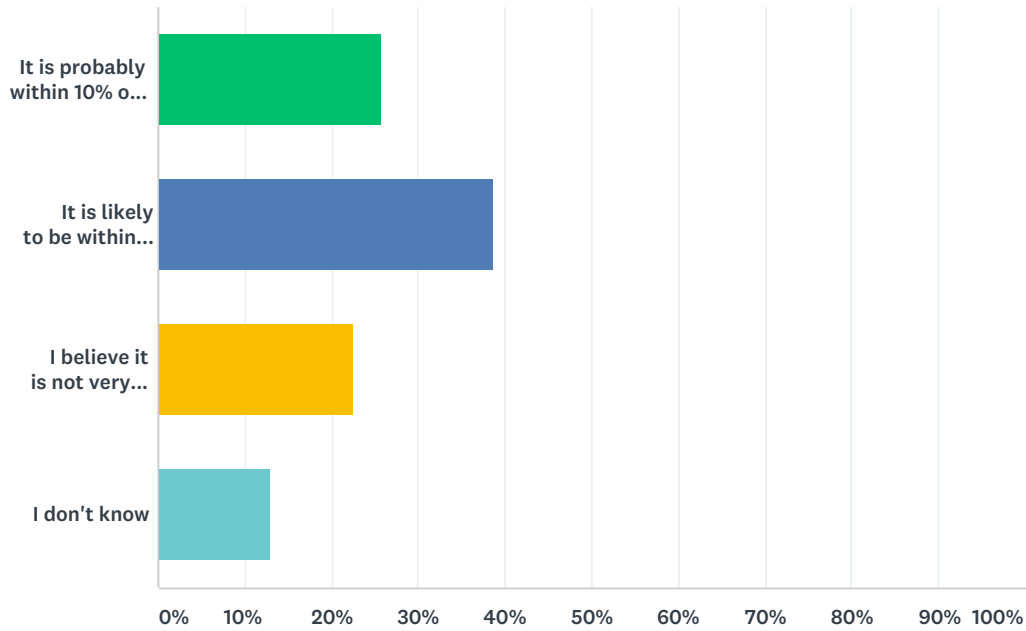


# Q1 How would you categorize the accuracy of your Continuum's PIT unsheltered count?

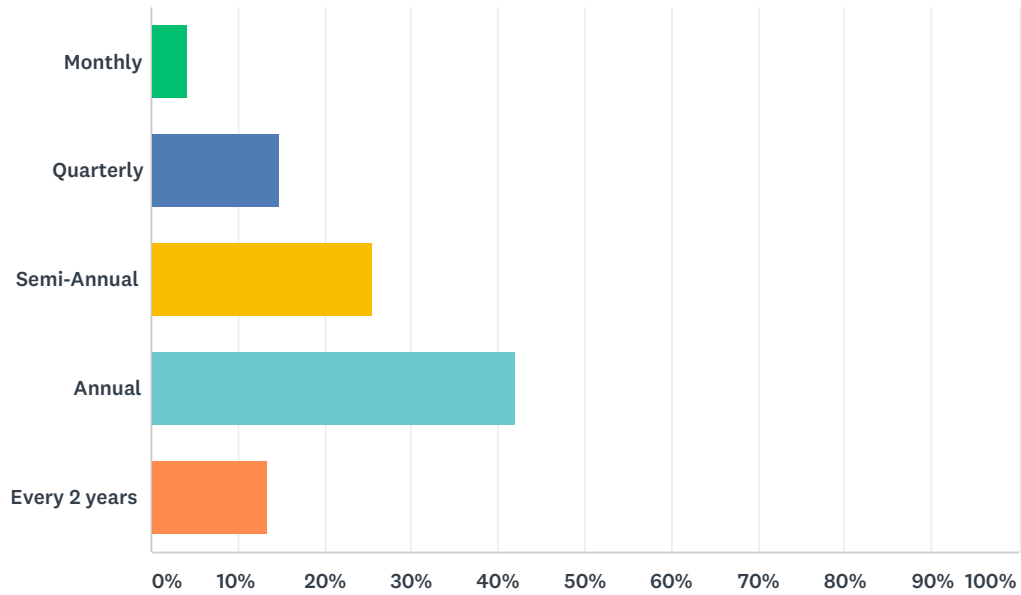

## Q2 How often do you think CoCs should complete PIT counts?

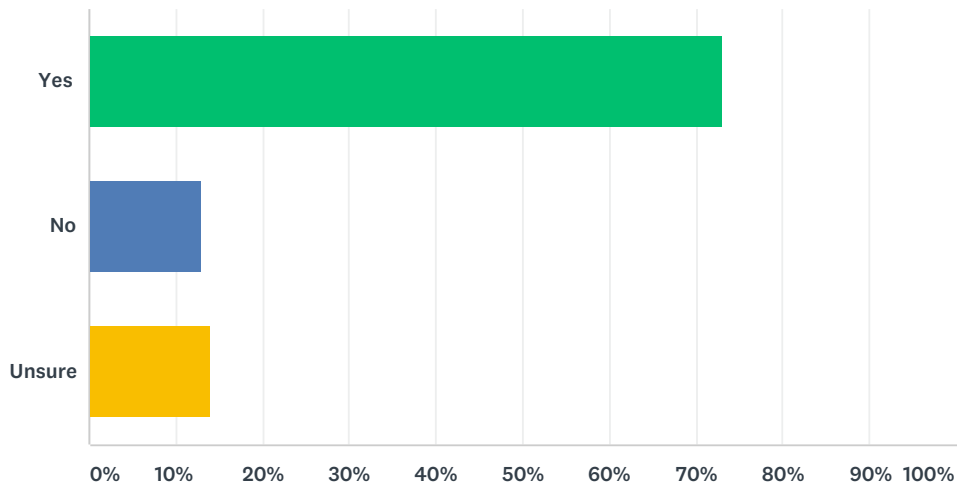

### Q3 Do you think that people in Domestic Violence beds should be considered homeless?

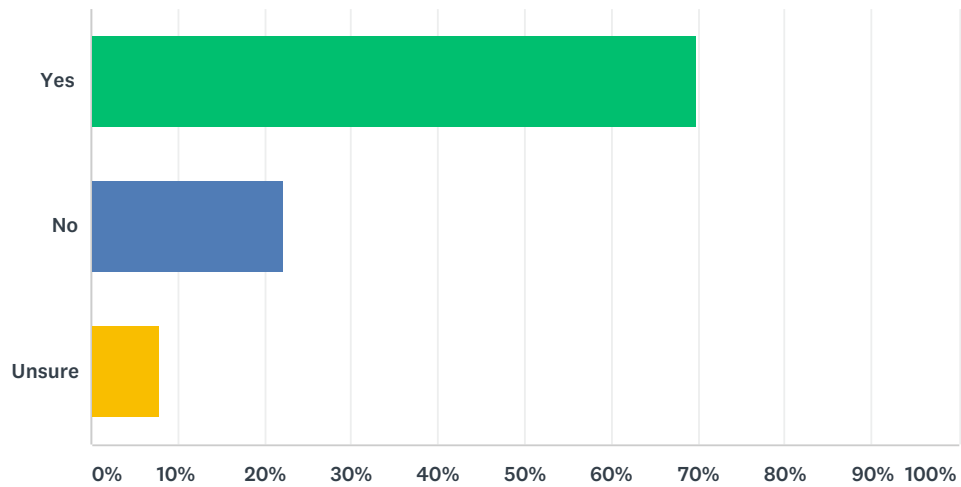

## Q4 Do you think that families in transitional housing should be considered homeless?

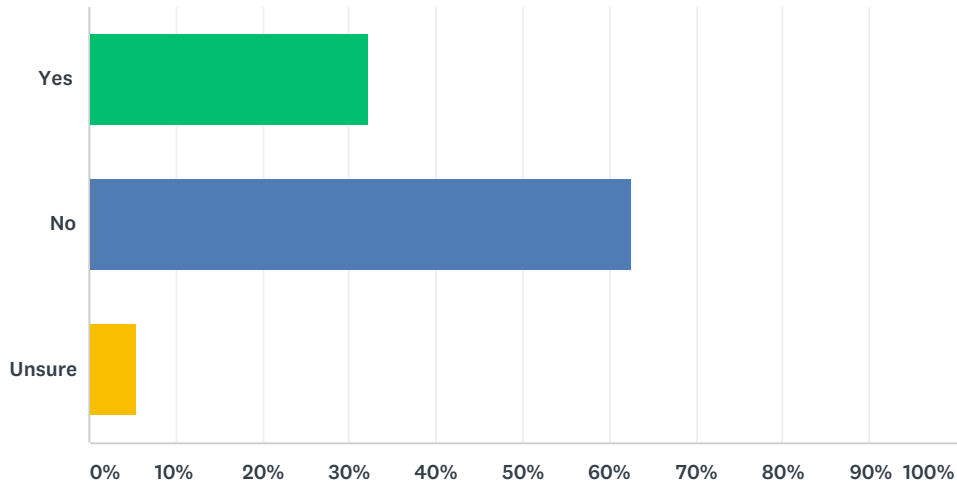

### Q5 Do you feel there is too much funding emphasis on chronic homelessness?

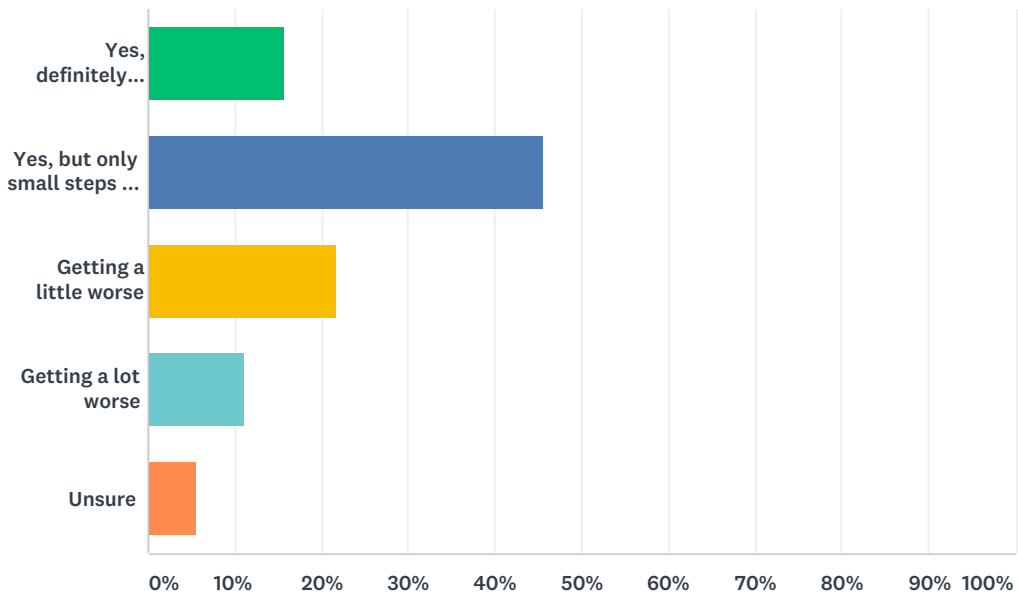

## Q6 Do you think homelessness is getting better (declining) in your community?

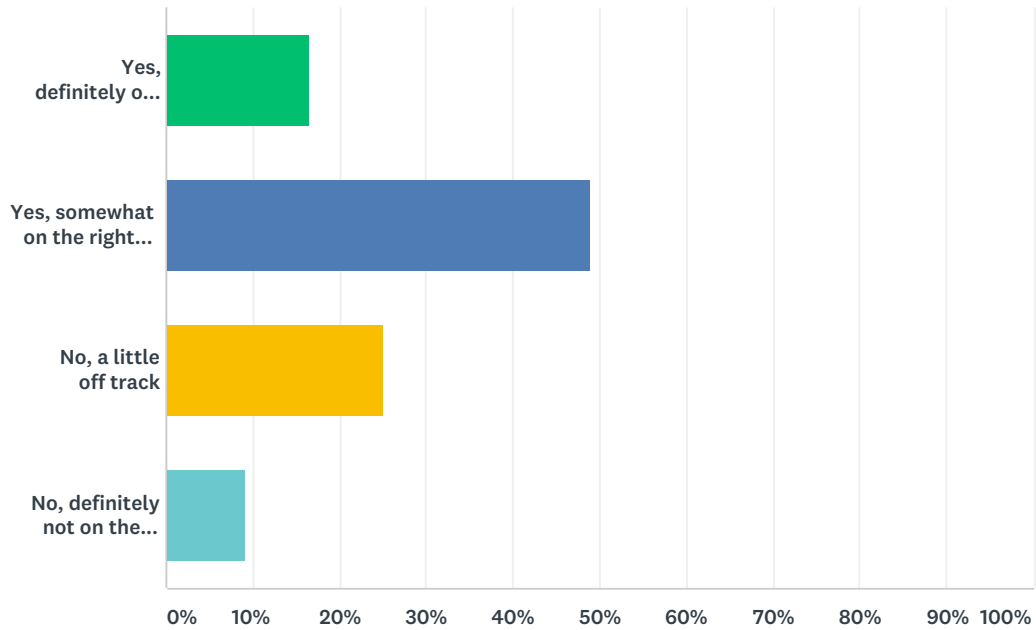

### Q7 Do you feel that HUD's Homeless strategy is on the right track?

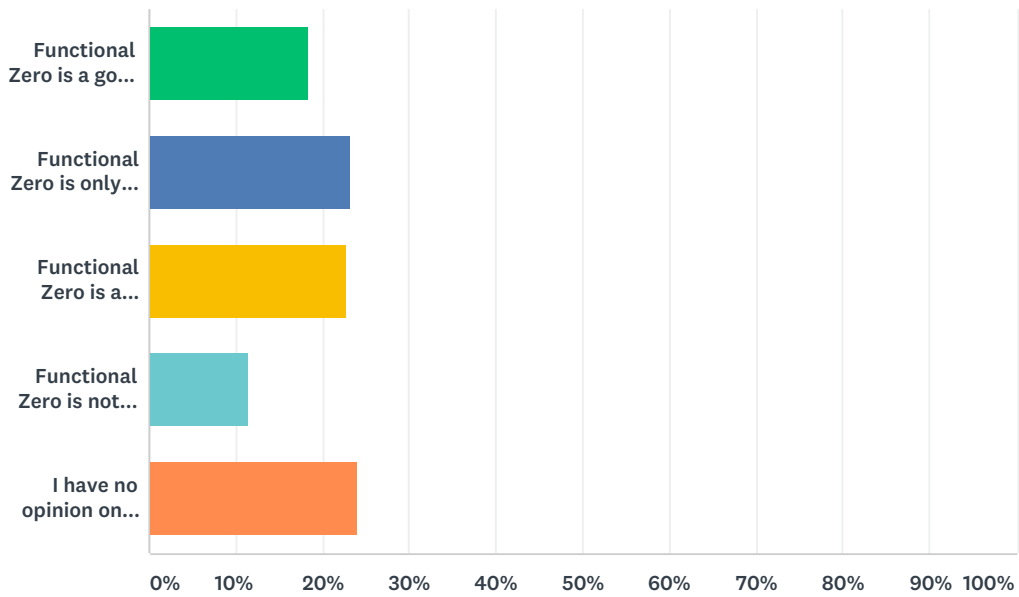

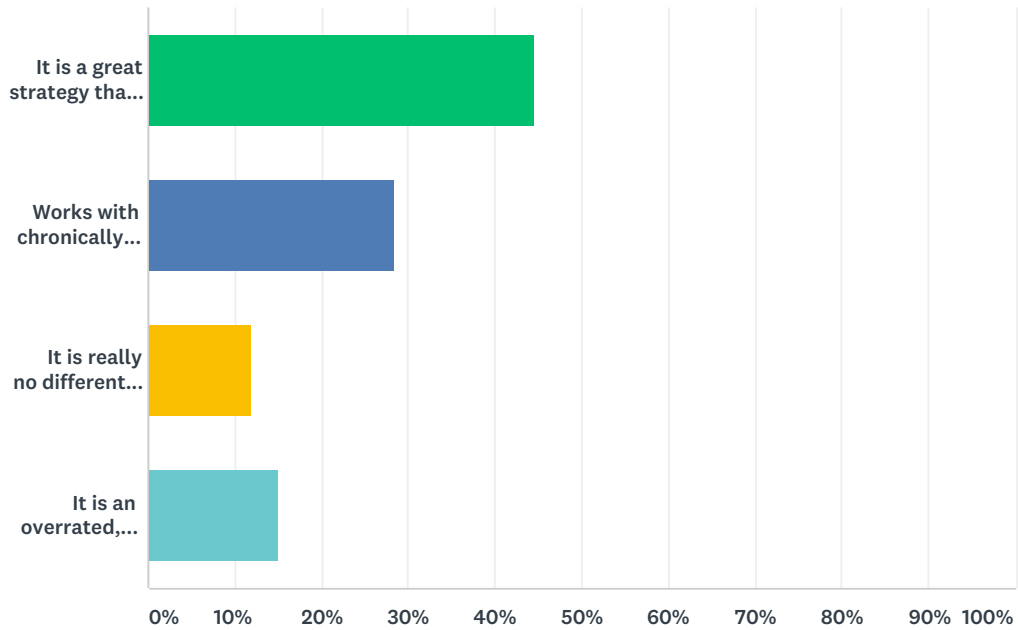

### Q9 Which choice best fits your opinion of Housing First?

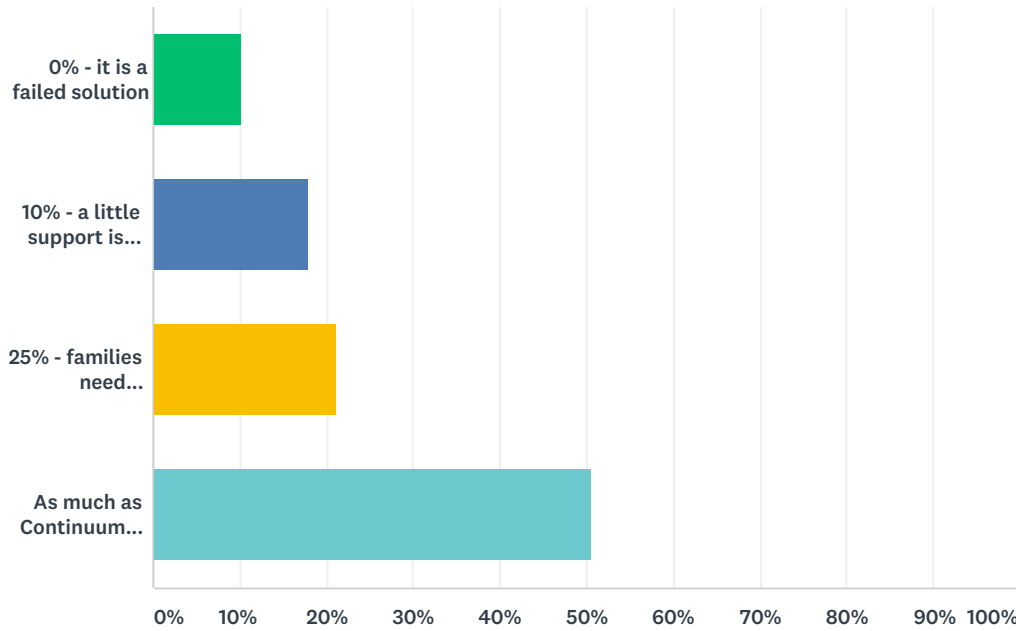
